**SUPPRESSIVE PERSON DECLARE
RICHARD AND VICKI (HOVERSON) PALMER**

Richard and Vicki Palmer of Seattle, WA are hereby declared Suppressive Persons.

In May of 2010, it was discovered that Vicki and Richard had been reading websites that carried the enemy line against the Church: websites by the St. Petersburg Times, Marty Rathbun and other whistleblowers speaking out against the Church. It is known that Vicki and Richard have spread these allegations to at least seven other Scientologists, mostly family members.

Vicki and Richard have resisted all lesser ethics gradients. KR's were written by several of the Scientologists who received their comm. The Church attempted to put their ethics in by starting a whispering campaign to malign their reputations. Vicki spoke to a Flag MAA about her concerns in the Church. The Flag MAA was unable to convince her that everything she had read on the internet was lies because it had been spoken by an SP.

Although it would be more correct to label them "PTS" since they are being a source of trouble to the Church, Vicki and Richard are being declared "Suppressive" because it is the only label that carries with it mandatory disconnection by all other Scientologists in good standing. Since Vicki and Richard appear unwilling to cease spreading these rumors, then it is the duty of every Scientologist to cut comm with them so they will not be exposed to the rumors.

Specifically, Vicki and Richard have been spreading rumors that David Miscavige, Chairman of the Board RTC, had physically assaulted Sea Org members and members of Int Management at the Int Base. This is a claim alleged in the St. Petersburg Times by Marty Rathbun (27 year Sea Org member and former Inspector General for Ethics RTC). These claims were also witnessed and substantiated by other former long-time Sea Org members: Mike Rinder (former spokesman for the Church), Jeff Hawkins, Amy Scobee, Marc Headley, Steve Hall, and Tom DeVocht. The truth is that these people are all lying because they are declared SPs. Vicki refused to believe that all of these people were lying. She asserted that if David Miscavige were an SP he would be labeling all of these people as SPs to prevent Scientologists from listening to them.

Vicki even questioned the legitimacy of David Miscavige as leader of the Church. She asked for proof that Ron turned leadership over to him or proof of his level of training or processing. These matters are irrelevant since his stats are up, including the number of Ideal Orgs opened in the last few years and the number of books sold since the Basics were released. She insisted that the proper stat would be how many Clears and auditors had been made since he'd taken over but these stats are not available for public to see.

Vicki and Richard failed to immediately appear for a duly convened Committee of Evidence held in Los Angeles. They were summoned by phone 24 hours after it commenced. They were not given a written copy of the Bill of Particulars because they might have posted it on the internet to be held up to ridicule. They were not informed of what they were being charged with or what evidence was going to be used against them because this would have given them time to prepare a case. Since they did not appear in their defense it is assumed that they are guilty on all charges.

They are hereby found guilty of the following High Crimes per HCO PL 7 Mar 1965RB I, SUPPRESSIVE ACTS, SUPPRESSION OF SCIENTOLOGY AND SCIENTOLOGISTS:

CONTINUED ADHERENCE TO A PERSON OR GROUP PRONOUNCED A SUPPRESSIVE PERSON OR GROUP BY HCO.

Vicki and Richard refused to disconnect from known SPs, Tony and Marie-Joe DePhillips, claiming that they had never been PTS to Tony in the 20 years they'd known him and that Marie-Joe was one of the nicest people they'd ever met. This in spite of the fact that Tony and Marie-Joe had publicly departed the Church of Scientology, making outrageous claims of human rights violations within the church.

MUTINY

Even though Vicki and Richard never advised anyone to leave the church, the lies they were spreading would have encouraged people to leave the church if they ever found out they were true.

SEEKING TO SPLINTER OFF AN AREA OF SCIENTOLOGY AND DENY IT PROPERLY CONSTITUTED AUTHORITY FOR PERSONAL PROFIT, PERSONAL POWER OR "TO SAVE THE ORGANIZATION FROM THE HIGHER OFFICERS OF SCIENTOLOGY."

Although the rumors Vicki and Richard were spreading were not anti-LRH or anti-Scientology, they were defaming to the highest leader of the Church, David Miscavige. It is a High Crime to attempt to save Scientology from upper management.

Any certs or awards that may have been issued to Vicki or Richard Palmer are hereby cancelled. Any licenses they may have signed to use the marks of Dianetics or Scientology are cancelled as well and they may not use the marks in any manner whatsoever.

No Scientologist should attempt to communicate with Vicki or Richard or anyone who is in comm with them. Scientologists need to create a buffer zone in this manner. The rumors mentioned are so compelling that if they manage to get into the mind of a Scientologist they may find themselves asking questions that will result in the same condition.

Should Vicki or Richard come to their senses and recant, they are to do steps A-E of HCO PL 7 Mar 1965RB I, SUPPRESSIVE ACTS, SUPPRESSION OF SCIENTOLOGY AND SCIENTOLOGISTS. Their only Scientology terminal is the International Justice Chief via the Continental Justice Chief.
